### **APPLICATION METHOD**

- 1. Make sure that the surfaces are dry, leveled in position and ready for application.
- 2. Spread the adhesive to a surface area of 2 m<sup>2</sup>, which can be used in the adhesive's open time.
- 3. For the application of vinyl wallpaper or carpet, first the substrate must be completely covered with adhesive and then fix the Wallpaper or the vinyl carpet within 20 30 minutes after application of adhesive while it is still wet.
- 4. Press it firmly ensuring that the adhesive covers the back portion of the vinyl wallpaper or the vinyl carpet completely.
- 5. Keep away from applied surfaces until its completely dried.
- 6. For outside application don't start work if rain is forecasted for the following 24 hrs.

### **CLEANING & DISPOSAL**

- Wet material is cleaned immediately with Water
- The Tools & the excess material should be cleaned immediately with water before it gets dry
- Dry product may stains can be removed mechanically
- Dispose the waste according to the local regulations
